#### ITINERARY

##### 1<sup>st</sup> day | Arrival in Lima (154 masl)

Arrival at Lima's international airport in the afternoon or night. Meeting with our personnel, transfer and lodging in the hotel (private service, English-speaking assistance). Overnight.

##### 2<sup>nd</sup> day | Lima / Cusco (3.399 masl) **B**

Breakfast in the hotel. In the morning, visit the **historical center** (entrance fee to the Cathedral is included) (private service, English-speaking guide). In the afternoon, transfer to the airport to take the flight to Cusco (private service, Spanish-speaking driver). Upon arrival, transfer to the hotel. Overnight.

##### 3<sup>rd</sup> day | Cusco **B**

Breakfast in the hotel. In the morning, **historical center walking tour** (entrance fees to the Cathedral and Santo Domingo/Coricancha are included) and transfer to the ruins of **Sacsayhuaman, Qenqo, Puca Pucara** and **Tambomachay** (private service, English-speaking guide). Afternoon is at leisure. Overnight.

##### 4<sup>th</sup> day | Cusco / Aguas Calientes (trekking) (2.060 masl) **B BL D**

Breakfast In the hotel. Transfer to the trailhead by train. The first archaeological site to visit is **Chachabamba** (2.250mt/7.380ft), showing an architectural beauty in the same valley. Then gradually ascend (3h) to the fascinating **Huiñay Huayna** (2.650mt/8.695ft), where you will taste a box lunch. After a break, continue the expedition by the semi-tropical forest towards the mystical **Intipunku** (Sun Gate), place where you will enjoy the first panoramic view of the -enigmatic citadel of Machu Picchu surrounded by mountains covered with vegetation, rivers and valleys. From here, descend (30min) to the top of the citadel to rest and take pictures. Then, take the bus to Aguas Calientes for dinner and overnight (shared service, English-speaking guide).

##### 5<sup>th</sup> day | Aguas Calientes / Machu Picchu (2.430 masl) / Cusco **B**

Breakfast in the hotel. Depart on shuttle bus to **Machu Picchu** (2.430mt/7.970ft) to enjoy the sunrise in this magical place and take a guided tour (2-3h). In the afternoon, descend to Aguas Calientes to take the train back to Ollantaytambo or Poroy station. Upon arrival, transfer to Cusco (shared service, English-speaking guide). Overnight.

*The travel ticket allows the transport clients and their hand luggage (01 bag or backpack) with a weight of no more than 05kg/11lb and with a maximum size of 62 linear inches/157 cm (length + height + width), with the cars intended for this purpose. We will take the luggage from the Sacred Valley to the hotel in Cusco.*

*Note: 2-day Inka trail shared service needs 3 pax to confirm the departure. Nevertheless, we can open a departure with 2 pax 3 months before the departure. Less than 3 months, it is not possible to open a departure with 2 pax.*

### **6<sup>th</sup> day | Cusco / Puno (3.827 masl) B L**

Breakfast in the hotel. Transfer to station to take the touristic bus to Puno, lunch buffet at Sicuani (km. 380, schedule could change: 08.00/17.00) (shared service, Spanish/English-speaking guide). Along the way, visit the **chapel of Andahuaylillas**, the **Raqchi ruins**, and the **Pukara Museum**. Upon arrival, transfer to the hotel. Overnight.

### **7<sup>th</sup> day | Puno / Uros floating islands B L D**

Breakfast in the hotel.

09.00 Transfer to the port to embark towards the Uros Islands

09.45 Upon arrival, lodging in the local managed by the locals

10.00 Visit the Uros floating islands

13.00 Lunch in lodge

15.00 Visit the Titicaca National Reserve

16.00 Fishing: accompanied by the local, nets will be laid in the lake

(private service, English-speaking guide)

19.00 Dinner with the locals and overnight.

### **8<sup>th</sup> day | Uros floating islands / Taquile Island / Uros floating islands B L D**

Breakfast at the lodge. Day dedicated to visit **Taquile Island**, lunch included (private service, English-speaking guide). Dinner with the locals. Overnight.

### **9<sup>th</sup> day | Uros floating islands / Puno / Lima**

Breakfast in the hotel. Transfer to Juliaca's airport to take the flight to Lima (private service, English-speaking guide).

- ✓ All transfers on arrival and departure of each locality, assisted by expert personnel. **NOTE:** In Lima, in/out pax will be assisted by our Spanish-speaking driver, except for the international arrival transfer, which is always attended by our English-speaking personnel.

    - Bus from Machu Picchu to Aguas Calientes.

    - Expedition-class train from Aguas Calientes to Ollantaytambo.
    - Return in a minibus from Ollantaytambo train station to Cusco.
  - Food: We serve highly nutritious food on the hike so that you can quickly recover your energy along the way. We can accommodate special dietary needs, including vegetarian, allergies, and diabetes, among others. Please advise us of any special dietary needs at the time of reservation.
  - Professional guides: Our guides are fluent in English and have five to twelve years of experience in different hikes of the region. They are skilled at managing groups under pressure and are experts at first aid and rescue techniques. The majority of them come from different Andean communities and bring with them their cultural heritage. Along with the rest of the field team, our guides will make your journey a unique experience.
  - Emergency Equipment: Satellite telephones, medical assistance by satellite calling, radios with 10km range and 8 frequencies, first aid kit (we carry a full complement of over-the-counter medication, including alcohol, hydrogen peroxide, tincture of iodine, germicidal soap, cotton, gauze, bandages, adhesive medical tape, surgical gloves, analgesics for muscle and stomach pain,

antipyretics, anti-allergy medication, anti-inflammatories, oral rehydration salts, laxatives, burn cream, splints, blood pressure measuring devices, and thermometers)

### CONSIDERATIONS ON THE INCA TRAIL

**Entrance:** In order to protect the historic road, authorities only allowed the entry of 500 people by day, including porters, guides and cooks. Therefore, it is recommended to book places in advance, since many places are already filled three or four months, especially in high season (June to September).

**Reservations:** To book a place, we must submit to the Inca Trail Regulatory Office, complete information of each passenger's full name, gender, passport number, age and date of birth, nationality, occupation and payment. Passport data should be the same as those provided to this office; otherwise, you will have trouble accessing the road, whereupon Legendary Peru is not responsible. If you change the passenger's passport number, or send us a copy 10 days before the start of the trail for management (cost \$15.00) or bring the old passport along with the new when starting the trek. If the passenger is unable to make the trek, the cost of entry to the Inca Trail is not refundable.

**Carriers:** If the Inca Trail is done with private services, each passenger has a personal porter to carry up to 8 kg. If services are shared (SIC), passenger must pay extra if they want a personal porter. The programs do include porters who carry the camping equipment and cooking, but not the passenger's personal effects.

#### Penalties:

\*Because of the strict Regulations of the Machu Picchu Park, even you have made your reservation; you cannot cancel the space that you have reserved. You may also not alter the name or date of the reservation. If you are unable to come on the date you have reserved, we cannot reimburse you.

\*We cannot reimburse the entrance fee to the Inca Trail permits because they are non-refundable and we purchase the tickets from Machu Picchu Park when you reserve your spot.

\*If you cancel between 30 and 10 days before your trek, you must pay 50% of the total cost.

\*If you cancel Between 10 and 3 days before your trek, you must pay 80% of the total cost.

\*If you cancel one or two days before your trek, you must pay 100% of the total cost.

\*In the exceptional case that you decide to head back once you have started the trail, you must pay additional expenses: such as food and transportation.
