#### ITINERARY

##### 1<sup>st</sup> day | Arrival in Lima (154 masl)

Arrival at Lima's international airport in the afternoon or night. Meeting with our personnel, transfer and lodging in the hotel (private service, English-speaking assistance). Overnight.

##### 2<sup>nd</sup> day | Lima **B** **L**

Breakfast in the hotel. Day dedicated to visit the **historical center**, including **San Francisco Convent and its catacombs, Nazarenas Church, Church and Convent of Santo Domingo, the Cathedral** and its **Religious Art Museum**, lunch included (private service, English-speaking guide). Overnight.

*Santo Domingo: closes on January 1st, July 1st and December 25th*

*Religious Art Museum: closed Saturdays (afternoon) and Sundays*

##### 3<sup>rd</sup> day | Lima / Chiclayo (27 masl) / Trujillo (33 masl) **B**

Breakfast in the hotel. Transfer to the airport to take the flight to Chiclayo. Upon arrival, we will follow the **Pope Leo XIV Route in Chiclayo**, visiting Chiclayo's Cathedral, the Church of Santa María de la Magdalena in Eten City, and the Church of San Pedro in Monsefú, sites where the Pope celebrated masses, confirmations, and baptisms for over eight years. Then, transfer to Trujillo (km. 220, 4 hours) (private service, Spanish-speaking guide). Overnight.

##### 4<sup>th</sup> day | Trujillo / Lima **B** **L**

Breakfast in the hotel. Full day dedicated to exploring the **Pope Leo XIV Route in Trujillo**, visiting the Santa Rita de Casia Parish (one of the first churches he promoted as an Augustinian friar), the Santo Tomas de Villanueva Convent (where his belongings and religious mementos are preserved intact, as he lived here for 10 years), the Nuestra Señora de Monserrat Parish (founded by then-Father Robert), the San Carlos y San Marcelo Major Seminary (where the Pope taught and trained future priests), the Archbishopric of Trujillo (where he served as judicial vicar), Trujillo's Plaza de Armas, and the Pizarro pedestrian promenade. Lunch is included. Then, transfer to the airport for your flight to Lima (private service, Spanish-speaking guide). Upon arrival, transfer to the hotel. Overnight.

##### 5<sup>th</sup> day | Lima / Arequipa (2.300 masl) **B**

Breakfast in the hotel. Transfer to the airport to take the flight to Arequipa. Upon arrival, transfer and lodging in the hotel.

In the afternoon, visit the **Cathedral and its museum**, the **Santa Catalina Monastery**, and the **Compañía de Jesús Church and its dome** (private service, English-speaking guide). Overnight.

*Cathedral's museum: closed on Sundays*

*Santa Catalina: closes on January 1st, Holy Thursday (from midday), Holy Friday, and December 25th*

### 6<sup>th</sup> day | Arequipa **B**

Breakfast in the hotel. Morning dedicated to visit the **Santa Teresa Monastery** and the **Recoleta Convent** (private service, English-speaking guide). Afternoon is at leisure. Overnight.

*Santa Teresa: closes January 1st, Holy Thursday and Friday, and December 24th and 25th*

*Recoleta: closed on Sundays and holidays*

### 7<sup>th</sup> day | Arequipa / Cusco (3.399 masl) **B**

Breakfast in the hotel. Transfer to the airport to take the flight to Cusco. Upon arrival, transfer and lodging in the hotel. In the afternoon, **historical center walking tour** (entrance fees to the **Cathedral** and **Santo Domingo/Coricancha** are included) and transfer to the ruins of **Sacsayhuaman**, **Qenqo**, **Puca Pucara** and **Tambomachay** (private service, English-speaking guide). Overnight.

*Cathedral: closed on Holy Thursday and Friday*

*Santo Domingo/Coricancha: closed on Sundays in the morning*

### 8<sup>th</sup> day | Cusco **B**

Breakfast in the hotel. Visit to the Catholic precincts in the south of Cusco, which date from the XVII and XVIII centuries, whose baroque and renaissance artistic manifestations through architecture, painting and sculpture are perfectly combined with the warmth of its villages and customs of its inhabitants. On the itinerary, we will visit: **Andahuaylillas** (which is known as the Sistine Chapel, **Huaro** (the small town of Huaro is located at 4 Km. south of Andahuaylillas. Its white church dedicated to John the Baptist was built at the end of the 17th century. Its structure, made up of a single nave, is of classic style. Its façade is enlivened by indigenous decorations and flanked by a bell gable. Inside, the Renaissance altar is among the oldest of Peru. However, the magnificent pair of frescos made by Tadeo Escalante, situated on both sides of the entrance gate, is undoubtedly the most fascinating artwork in the church), and **Canincunca** (its chapel dedicated to the Virgin of Candelaria was probably built at the beginning of the 17th century for evangelizing the indigenous populations. It stands above Urcos Lake on a significant pre-Hispanic site. The cemetery that sits on the hill behind the chapel holds remains, which dates to the Incan Empire. The inside of the chapel contains an Andean Baroque iconography such as representations of vizcachas and a representation of the Virgin of Candelaria) (private service, English-speaking guide).

In the afternoon, transfer to Ollantaytambo Station (private service, Spanish-speaking driver) to board the train to Aguas Calientes (almost 1.30-hour journey, subject to availability). Upon arrival, you will be picked up by hotel staff who will escort you to the hotel to check-in. Overnight.

### 9<sup>th</sup> day | Aguas Calientes / Machu Picchu (2.430 masl) / Cusco **B**

Breakfast in the hotel. At the proper time, your local guide will pick you up from your hotel to take the 30-minute shuttle bus up to **Machu Picchu** (private service, English-speaking guide). After the guided tour, the local guide will leave you and you will take the shuttle bus to Aguas Calientes town. Then, collect your own luggage and walk around 5 minutes to the train station for your train back to Ollantaytambo (almost 1.30-hour journey, subject to availability). Upon arrival, transfer to Cusco (almost 2-hour journey) (private service, Spanish-speaking driver). Overnight.

***The train ticket allows the transport clients and their hand luggage (01 bag or backpack) with a weight of no more than 8kg/17.64lb and with a maximum size of 62 linear inches/157 cm (length + height + width), with the cars intended for this purpose. The main luggage will stay in the hotel in Cusco.***

### MACHU PICCHU

1. Although there has been an increase in capacity at the archaeological site in high season (from 4,500 to 5,600), the availability of tickets is limited, and they tend to sell out quickly. Between April and November, it is preferable to buy admission tickets as far in advance as possible, which once purchased are non-refundable.
2. The archaeological site is open from 6am to 5pm.
3. In 2021, with the objective of conserving this wonder of humanity, 5 tourist circuits to visit Machu Picchu were established. Through a Ministerial Resolution, the Ministry of Culture of Peru has modified these circuits. In that sense, from June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024, there are 3 new circuits that group 10 routes.

#### **Circuit 1 or Panoramic Circuit**

**The visit includes the upper part of the citadel but does NOT include a visit to its interior. You can include Machu Picchu Mountain or one of the high season variants: Inti Punku or Inca Bridge**

It includes the agricultural sector I C – Kallancas that covers: Upper and lower platform next to the Guardian's house, platform sector prior to the Puente Inca sector, platforms below the Guardian's house and the Road to Machu Picchu Mountain. The visit and/or access to these sectors depends on one of the following routes chosen by the visitor:

- \* [Route 1-A](#): Panoramic Circuit (time: +/- 2h30m) + Route to Machu Picchu Mountain (with 2 shifts: 7am to 7.30am and 9am to 9.30am) (time: +/- 2h30m)
- \* [Route 1-B](#): Panoramic Circuit (time: +/- 2h30m)

Likewise, during the high season period, the following routes will also be enabled:

- \* [Route 1-C](#): Panoramic Circuit (time: +/- 2h30m) + Route to Portada Inti Punku (time: +/- 3h)
- \* [Route 1-D](#): Panoramic Circuit (time: +/- 2h30m) + Route to Puente Inca (time: +/- 3h)

#### **Circuit 2 or Llaqta Circuit / Classic Machu Picchu Circuit**

**The visit includes the internal part of the citadel. From the upper or lower terraces, you can take the classic photo of Machu Picchu**

It includes the agricultural sector I C and the urban sectors I, II, IV and V, which includes: Platforms associated with the Guardian House, Llaqta Punku: entrance to the urban sector, Las Canteras Sector and

Mirador del Templo del Sol, Botanical Garden Space, Main Temple and Temple of the Three Windows, Sacred Rock and Qolqas Sector. The visit and/or access to these sectors depends on one of the following routes chosen by the visitor:

- \* [Route 2-A](#): Classic Circuit, route to higher terrace (time: +/- 2h30m)
- \* [Route 2-B](#): Classic Circuit, route to lower terrace (time: +/- 2h30m)
- *Between both circuits there is only a small difference at the entrance, but practically, in both the same places are visited.*
- *Unfortunately, the visit no longer includes the area known as Intihuatana or Sun Clock, which was one of the most iconic parts of the citadel.*

### **Circuit 3 or Royal Circuit**

**The visit includes the lower part of the citadel. You can include the Huayna Picchu Mountain or one of the high season variants: Huchuy Picchu Mountain or Great Cavern**

It includes agricultural sector B and urban sectors I, V and VI, which includes: Agricultural platforms associated with the Qolqas, water sources, Sun Temple, House of the Inca, Enclosure of the Three Covers, Enclosure of the Twelve Vagins, The Qolqas and Water Mirrors. The visit and/or access to these sectors depends on one of the following routes chosen by the visitor:

- \* [Route 3-A](#): Royal Circuit (time: +/- 2h30m) + Route to Wayna Picchu Mountain (with 2 shifts: 7am to 7.30am and 10am to 10.30am) (time: +/- 3h)
- \* [Route 3-B](#): Royal Circuit (time: +/- 2h30m) *suggested route for disabled people*

Likewise, during the high season the following routes will also be enabled:

- \* [Route 3-C](#): Royal Circuit (time: +/- 2h30m) + Route to Great Cavern (time: +/- 4h)
- \* [Route 3-D](#): Royal Circuit (time: +/- 2h30m) + Route to Huchuy Picchu Mountain (time: +/- 2h)

### **IMPORTANT**

1. We will give priority to circuit 2 (both routes) because these options are recommended for first-time visitors to Machu Picchu. If we do not find availability for this circuit, we will proceed with the others, after coordinating with you.
2. Tickets are purchased with passport data and changes are not allowed. Once purchased, they are non-refundable. At most, tickets can be purchased with an expired passport, but the passenger is obliged to physically carry it with them and show it upon entering the site.
