#### ITINERARY

##### 1<sup>st</sup> day | Arrival in Lima (154 masl)

Arrival at Lima's international airport in the afternoon or night. Meeting with our personnel, transfer and lodging in hotel (private service, English-speaking assistance). Overnight.

##### 2<sup>nd</sup> day | Lima **B**

Breakfast in hotel. In the morning, **Lima's city tour** (entrance fee to San Francisco Convent is included) (World Cultural Heritage from 1988) (shared service, English-speaking guide). Rest of the day is at leisure. Overnight.

##### 3<sup>rd</sup> day | Lima / Huaraz (3.052 masl) **B**

Breakfast in hotel. Transfer to the station to take the bus to Huaraz (km. 408, schedule could change: 09.30/18.00). Upon arrival, transfer to the hotel. Rest of the day is at leisure. Overnight.

##### 4<sup>th</sup> day | Huaraz / Chavín de Huántar / Huaraz **B**

Breakfast in hotel. Full day excursion dedicated to visit **Chavín de Huántar** (World Cultural Heritage from 1985) (shared service, Spanish/English-speaking guide), 116 km from Huaraz, at the Callejón de Conchucos, a beautiful valley at 3,177 m altitude. It was a great and important ceremonial center built before 800 BC. Overnight.

##### 5<sup>th</sup> day | Huaraz / Huascarán / Llanganuco / Huaraz **B**

Breakfast at the hotel. Full day excursion to the Huascarán National Park (World Natural Heritage since 1985) (shared service, Spanish/English-speaking guide), crossing the typical village of Yungay, until reaching the **Llanganuco lagoon**, spectacular turquoise water mirrors from the snowcapped Huascarán and Huandoy, the highest mountains of Peru. Overnight.

##### 6<sup>th</sup> day | Huaraz / Sechín / Trujillo (34 masl) **B**

Breakfast at the hotel. Departure to Trujillo (private service, Spanish-speaking driver). Along the route, stop to visit the **ruins of Sechín** (with Spanish-speaking guide), one of the oldest and extraordinary ceremonial centers of Peru. Arrival in Trujillo and accommodation at the hotel. Overnight.



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### 7<sup>th</sup> day | Trujillo / Lima **B**

Breakfast in hotel. Day dedicated to **visit the city**, the **Archaeological Museum** and **Chan Chan**, the world's largest adobe city (World Cultural Heritage from 1986), lunch included at **Huanchaco** beach (*shared service, English-speaking guide*). Then, transfer to the airport to take the flight to Lima. Upon arrival, transfer to the hotel. Overnight.

### 8<sup>th</sup> day | Lima / Nasca (588 masl) **B**

Breakfast in hotel. Transfer to the station to take the bus to Nasca (km. 450, schedule could change: 07.35/15.45). Upon arrival, transfer to the hotel. Overnight.

### 9<sup>th</sup> day | Nasca / Arequipa (2.300 masl) **B**

Breakfast in hotel. Transfer to the local airport to **flight over the Nasca Lines** (World Cultural Heritage from 1994) (almost 35-minute journey, weather conditions could delay or cancel the excursion) (*shared service, Spanish/English-speaking pilot guide*). In the afternoon, transfer to the station to take the bus to Arequipa (km. 600, schedule could change: 14.50/00.25+1). Upon arrival, transfer and lodging in the hotel. Overnight.

### 10<sup>th</sup> day | Arequipa / Puno (3.827 masl) **B**

Breakfast in hotel. In the morning, walking tour to the **historical center** and **Santa Catalina Convent** (World Cultural Heritage from 2000) (*private service, English-speaking guide*). Transfer to the station to take the bus to Puno (km. 300, schedule could change: 08.30/14.30). Upon arrival, meet with our personnel and transfer to the hotel. Overnight.

### 11<sup>th</sup> day | Puno / Titicaca Lake / Puno **B L**

Breakfast in hotel. Full day excursion to Titicaca Lake visiting the **Uros floating islands** and **Taquile Island** (the Taquile textile art and the Aymara communities are Intangible Cultural Heritages from 2008 and 2009 respectively), lunch at Taquile (*shared service, Spanish/English-speaking guide*). Overnight in hotel in Puno.

### 12<sup>th</sup> day | Puno / Cusco (3.399 masl) **B L**

Breakfast in hotel. Transfer to station to take the touristic bus to Cusco, lunch buffet at Sicuani (km. 380, schedule could change: 08.00/17.00) (*shared service, Spanish/English-speaking guide*). Along the way, visit the **Pukara Museum**, the **Raqchi ruins**, and the **chapel of Andahuaylillas**. At Puno, transfer and lodging in the hotel. Overnight.

### 13<sup>th</sup> day | Cusco **B**

Breakfast in hotel. In the morning, **historical center walking tour** (entrance fees to the Cathedral and Santo Domingo/Coricancha are included) and transfer to the ruins of **Sacsayhuaman**, **Qenqo**, **Puca Pucara** and **Tambomachay** (World Cultural Heritage from 1983) (*shared service, English-speaking guide*). In the afternoon, transfer to Ollantaytambo Station (*private service, Spanish-speaking driver*) to board the train to Aguas Calientes (almost 1.30-hour journey, subject to availability). Upon arrival, you will be picked up by hotel staff who will escort you to the hotel to check-in. Overnight.

### 14<sup>th</sup> day | Aguas Calientes / Machu Picchu (2.430 masl) / Cusco **B**

Breakfast in the hotel. At the proper time, your local guide will pick you up from your hotel to take the 30-minute shuttle bus up to **Machu Picchu** (*private service, English-speaking guide*). After the guided tour, the local guide will leave you and you will take the shuttle bus to Aguas Calientes town.



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Then, collect your own luggage and walk around 5 minutes to the train station for your train back to Ollantaytambo (almost 1.30-hour journey, subject to availability). Upon arrival, transfer to Cusco (almost 2-hour journey) (private service, Spanish-speaking driver). Overnight.

*The train ticket allows the transport clients and their hand luggage (01 bag or backpack) with a weight of no more than 8kg/17.64lb and with a maximum size of 62 linear inches/157 cm (length + height + width), with the cars intended for this purpose. The main luggage will stay in the hotel in Cusco.*

### 15<sup>th</sup> day | Cusco / Lima **B**

Breakfast in hotel. Transfer to the airport to take the flight to Lima (passengers are requested to be at the airport 3 hours before international flight).

### MACHU PICCHU

1. Although there has been an increase in capacity at the archaeological site in high season (from 4,500 to 5,600), the availability of tickets is limited, and they tend to sell out quickly. Between April and November, it is preferable to buy admission tickets as far in advance as possible, which once purchased are non-refundable.
2. The archaeological site is open from 6am to 5pm.
3. In 2021, with the objective of conserving this wonder of humanity, 5 tourist circuits to visit Machu Picchu were established. Through a Ministerial Resolution, the Ministry of Culture of Peru has modified these circuits. In that sense, from June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024, there are 3 new circuits that group 10 routes.

#### Circuit 1 or Panoramic Circuit

**The visit includes the upper part of the citadel but does NOT include a visit to its interior. You can include Machu Picchu Mountain or one of the high season variants: Inti Punku or Inca Bridge**



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It includes the agricultural sector I C – Kallancas that covers: Upper and lower platform next to the Guardian's house, platform sector prior to the Puente Inca sector, platforms below the Guardian's house and the Road to Machu Picchu Mountain. The visit and/or access to these sectors depends on one of the following routes chosen by the visitor:

- \* [Route 1-A](#): Panoramic Circuit (time: +/- 2h30m) + Route to Machu Picchu Mountain (with 2 shifts: 7am to 7.30am and 9am to 9.30am) (time: +/- 2h30m)
- \* [Route 1-B](#): Panoramic Circuit (time: +/- 2h30m)

Likewise, during the high season period, the following routes will also be enabled:

- \* [Route 1-C](#): Panoramic Circuit (time: +/- 2h30m) + Route to Portada Inti Punku (time: +/- 3h)
- \* [Route 1-D](#): Panoramic Circuit (time: +/- 2h30m) + Route to Puente Inca (time: +/- 3h)

### **Circuit 2 or Llaqta Circuit / Classic Machu Picchu Circuit**

**The visit includes the internal part of the citadel. From the upper or lower terraces, you can take the classic photo of Machu Picchu**

It includes the agricultural sector I C and the urban sectors I, II, IV and V, which includes: Platforms associated with the Guardian House, Llaqta Punku: entrance to the urban sector, Las Canteras Sector and Mirador del Templo del Sol, Botanical Garden Space, Main Temple and Temple of the Three Windows, Sacred Rock and Qolqas Sector. The visit and/or access to these sectors depends on one of the following routes chosen by the visitor:

- \* [Route 2-A](#): Classic Circuit, route to higher terrace (time: +/- 2h30m)
- \* [Route 2-B](#): Classic Circuit, route to lower terrace (time: +/- 2h30m)
- *Between both circuits there is only a small difference at the entrance, but practically, in both the same places are visited.*
- *Unfortunately, the visit no longer includes the area known as Intihuatana or Sun Clock, which was one of the most iconic parts of the citadel.*

### **Circuit 3 or Royal Circuit**

**The visit includes the lower part of the citadel. You can include the Huayna Picchu Mountain or one of the high season variants: Huchuy Picchu Mountain or Great Cavern**

It includes agricultural sector B and urban sectors I, V and VI, which includes: Agricultural platforms associated with the Qolqas, water sources, Sun Temple, House of the Inca, Enclosure of the Three Covers, Enclosure of the Twelve Vagins, The Qolqas and Water Mirrors. The visit and/or access to these sectors depends on one of the following routes chosen by the visitor:

- \* [Route 3-A](#): Royal Circuit (time: +/- 2h30m) + Route to Wayna Picchu Mountain (with 2 shifts: 7am to 7.30am and 10am to 10.30am) (time: +/- 3h)
- \* [Route 3-B](#): Royal Circuit (time: +/- 2h30m) *suggested route for disabled people*

Likewise, during the high season the following routes will also be enabled:

- \* [Route 3-C](#): Royal Circuit (time: +/- 2h30m) + Route to Great Cavern (time: +/- 4h)
- \* [Route 3-D](#): Royal Circuit (time: +/- 2h30m) + Route to Huchuy Picchu Mountain (time: +/- 2h)



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### IMPORTANT

1. We will give priority to circuit 2 (both routes) because these options are recommended for first-time visitors to Machu Picchu. If we do not find availability for this circuit, we will proceed with the others, after coordinating with you.
2. Tickets are purchased with passport data and changes are not allowed. Once purchased, they are non-refundable. At most, tickets can be purchased with an expired passport, but the passenger is obliged to physically carry it with them and show it upon entering the site.
